This indenture made and entered into this day 13 of June One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-One between Andrew J. Alldredge of the State of Alabama and County of Blount. Of our part and the deacons and their successors in office of Mud Creek Church of the County and State of the aforesaid of the other part with the said Andrew J. and Savillar Alldredge for an in the hand paid the receipt of is hereby acknowledged. Hath this day bargained, sold, delivered & conveyed to the deacons of Mud Creek Church and their successors in office forward, the following tract of land to wit: commencing at a black gum on the northwest corner, thence on the purposed line seventy yards to a white oak making that the southwest corner, thence to a black oak seventy six yards, the southeast corner, thence seventy yards to a black oak the northeast corner, thence to the black gum seventy-two yards the northwest corner containing one acre more or less. Lying in the north half of the northeast fourth of Section Thirteen, Township #10, Range #1 West, to have and to hold as long as the church shall exist at this place and when said church shall dissolve or remove the above obligation to be null & void.
